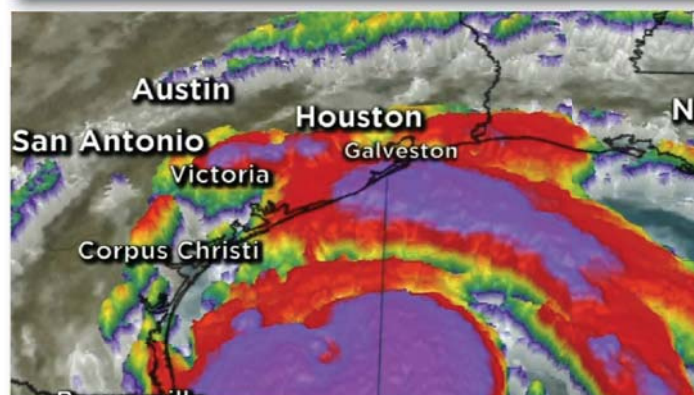

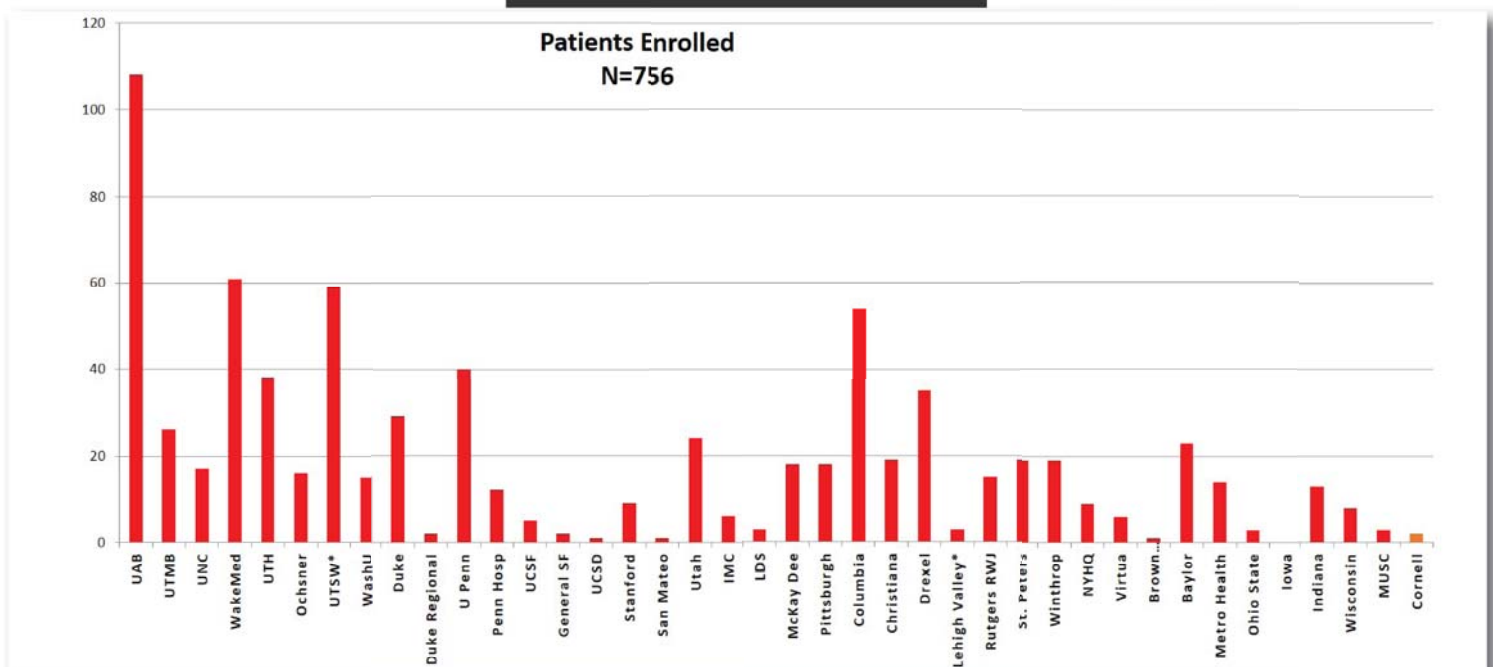
FYI
